



## DALRYMPLE BAY COAL TERMINAL UPGRADE

Tenix Robt Stone was recently awarded a major contract for the Dalrymple Bay Coal Terminal 7X project upgrade in Queensland, Australia. The project will involve the procurement, supply, installation and commissioning of a 1.4km long yard conveyor, two out-loading conveyors and a fully fitted out transfer tower. This will involve 300 tonnes of structural steel, chutes, drives, rollers and brakes, control systems, telemetry, motors and civil works.

Tenix Robt Stone's Projects Division will be managing the project with a construction team of engineers and tradesmen based on site in Mackay, Queensland. The fabricated structures will be supplied in combination with New Zealand and Australian fabricators to standards exceeding AS1554. The site team will also be a combination of Australian and New Zealand contractors.
